3. Play Area

Woodland Grants PR had a useful meeting with J. Afleck of the Forestry Commission when it was confirmed that we would be eligible for both a woodland improvement grant and a woodland management grant. More details would be required such as areas in order to establish the extent of grant available.

Community Council have funds for environmental work and which we may be eligible for.

SWT to carry out a woodland survey towards the end of June.

Countess Youth Centre want to get involved with our activities. We to liaise with Ann Hampshire.

Shelter Belt to sports field needed.

SNH potential funding for employee. To be considered at later stage.

Broxmouth Estate is presently for sale and given the extensive woodland this should be monitored.
