Wildlife (some felt this was covered)
- P14 (6.4) *What people would like*
Natural playground (chainsaw sculpture?)
Dog management generally. SB suggested the 3 main options of
a) dog toilet area
b) dog path
c) dog bins.
Picnic tables: near play area seemed best option
Bike track?:?
Shelter?
- P17 (6.10) Newsletters to groups (e.g. churches)
- P20 (7.2) *Dunbar Primary School: What They Would Like to Have in the Woods*
Notice board indoors (Hallhill?)
Fruit trees (Scottish Varieties?), hazels, nuts.
Mushroom logs
Woodland fair
Placenames (including old) on map .
